

# SIX GUN

A rootin', tootin', shootin' game of old west shenanigans

## OBJECT

Playin' as folks from the old west, you all shoot it out with each other and see who can be the first to collect 3 notches on their gun.

## SETUP

Everyone load your gun with the same 6 bullet cards.

Shuffle up them folks cards and deal 1 to each player. Don't show yer card to no one.

Take them poker chip things. If ya got fewer than 5 folks playin', take out a draw, a disarm, a peek, an' a reload.

Without lookin', give a chip to everyone. Put the rest face up in the middle of the table so everyone can see 'em.

## GAMEPLAY

On yer turn, you're gonna put ALL yer chips back into the pool. Each chip has a number on it. If that number is 1, take 1 chip outta the pool. If that number is 2, take 2 chips outta the pool. If ya got 2 chips already, use the lowest number.

After takin' the new chip(s), do what it says on the chip(s) in any order.



DISARM (1)

Spend another guy's bullet at random.

DRAW (1)

Start a shootout with another player.

HIDE (2)

No one can draw on you.

PEEK (1)

Look at someone else's card in secret.

RELOAD (2)

Put all yer bullets back in yer gun.







SWAP (2)


Throw away yer card and draw another.

## SHOOTOUTS

When you draw on someone, both of ya lay down yer folks card so everyone can see 'em. They all have some special stuff they can do, so make sure ya look.

Each of ya choose a bullet card from yer gun and lay it face down on the table. That bullet is spent and yer gonna leave it on the table for everyone to see.

Flip over yer bullets and figger out who won. If there's a tie, the LAW  beats an OUTLAW , an OUTLAW  beats the TOWNSFOLK , and the TOWNSFOLK  beats the LAW . If'n you still have a tie, then whoever drew on whom wins the shootout.

The winner of the shootout collects the loser's card and can use the  text during shootouts. Collect 3 cards to win. The other feller should pick a new folks card.
